New Bishops Appointed for Saint-Jérôme and for Joliette: Ottawa – His Holiness Pope Francis accepted the resignation of the Most Reverend Pierre Morissette as Bishop of the Diocese of Saint-Jérôme, and on May 20th the Most Reverend Raymond Poisson assumes the pastoral governance of the Diocese. Until now, Bishop Poisson was the Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Joliette and Coadjutor Bishop of the Diocese of Saint-Jérôme. Family Faith Formation Made Easy: Family Formation's catechesis model for families centers on weekly home Lessons for parents to help pass on the Catholic Faith to their children. **Home Lessons are made into a unique, challenging, and creative curriculum** designed to make living the faith a way of life and a life-long learning adventure. The lessons are easy to use and have been developed and used by regular parents with normal, busy lives. Each month from Sept. to May, families receive a packet of three weekly lessons in the mail. Relics of Padre Pio: The Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall has the great honour of receiving the relics of Padre Pio on **Monday, June 3rd** from 11 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. The six relics will be available for public veneration during these hours at the *Co-cathédrale de la Nativité* (300 Montreal Road, Cornwall, Ontario). At 7 p.m. there will be a Mass of Thanksgiving presided by Bishop Prendergast. Saint Padre Pio is a beloved Italian Capuchin Catholic priest who was canonized by John Paul II in 2002. During his lifetime, he became known for bearing the stigmata (wounds of Christ). Padre Pio also had a great impact on those who came into contact with him.
